The tools on this list are required and will be used during both years in the Construction Technology – Carpentry Program. Quality tools are essential when producing quality work. For that reason, you are encouraged to purchase quality tools.

Adjustable Wrench (8” – 12”) – Crescent	Pliers (slip joint and/or groove)
Aviation Snips (yellow handle – straight)	Safety Glasses/goggles
Calculator (Construction Master Pro)	(Must have ANSI Z87 Marking)
Carpenter’s Pencil	Screwdrivers (Standard and Phillips)
Chalk Line (Blue and Red)	Sliding T-bevel
Ear Protection (reusable ear plugs)	Square (Speed or Try)
Side Cutters (6”)	Square (Framing with rafter table)
Hammer: 16-20 oz. Finish (non-serrated)	Steel Tape (25’ or 30’) 1” wide Stanley
Hammer: 20-24 oz. Framing (serrated ok)	Tool belt (double nail pouch)
Hardhat – OSHA approved	Utility knife w/ extra blades
(Ratchet-type head band recommended)	Wood Chisel set (1/4”, 1/2”, 3/4” and 1”)
Nail Puller (Cat’s Paw and/or Wonder Bar)	Work Boots (Must be Safety approved)
Nail Sets: (1/32, 1/16, and 3/32)	(NO Tennis Shoes Allowed!!!)

Suggested Extra: Small tool box to store extra tools and equipment
